

Playground Duty

We thank you for volunteering for playground duty. It is important for students and teachers to have time away from each other. Your help makes this possible.

1. We ask that you arrive at school before 11:45 AM. Please sign in at the school office.
2. The first recess period (11:45-12:05) grades 3, 4 and 5 will be outside. The second recess (12:15-12:30) grades 6, 7, and 8 will be outside. The last recess period (12:30-12:50) grades 1 and 2 will be outside.
3. **Hot Lunch Schedule**
Grades 3, 4 and 5 = Recess 11:45-11:55 and Lunch 11:55
Grades 1 and 2 = Lunch 12:00 and Recess 12:30-12:50
Grades 6, 7, and 8 = Recess 12:15-12:30 and Lunch 12:30
4. Most children know what is expected:
 - a. They may play in their assigned sections only.
 - b. Playground balls are to be shared.
 - c. Games should not be exclusive of others who want to play.
 - d. No fighting is allowed.
 - e. No bad language is allowed.
 - f. No tackle games are to be played.
 - g. Students are to be respectful of each other, the teacher and the parents on duty.
 - h. Students may not go on to Long Green Pike for any reason.
 - i. They should not go onto the driveway entering the property.
 - j. Hard balls are not allowed on the playground.
 - k. Radios are not allowed on the playground.

At the end of each recess period, students should line up and walk to the school building to reenter.

If someone is injured:

Minor Injury: Send student with another child to the Nurse's Office to be taken care of.

Major Injury: **Do not move the student!** Send someone immediately to the office for help.

We are depending on you to keep the peace and see that students enjoy their brief recess period. If you see anything that is not in keeping with our philosophy, please remedy the situation. You and the teacher are the authority figures on the playground. Three parents and one teacher should be sufficient supervision if all adults take their work as important to the well being of our students.
